This past month we received great news in regards to our students Positive Action Assessments. TreSports teaches from the Positive Action curriculum where students focus on building the skills of learning and cooperation among students. Our instructional leaders teach, lecture, discuss and demonstrate the many lessons of this curriculum. Our students learn by listening, taking notes, journaling, playing games, worksheets, role playing or within small and large group discussions. During February and March, the teaching staff and students have reviews all aspects of the Positive Action information. The March assessment yielded a 95% average score. This is our highest class average since 2014! We attribute this to effective instructional leadership and an attentive group of students who are interested in understanding themselves more, as well as how to apply the positive cycle of feelings-thoughts-actions to their lives. A second success within this past month was the increased involvement and participation from parents during our weekly Parenting Wisely sessions. Several topics discussed have been the importance of family meetings, active listening, discipline and meeting our teenagers where they are as we
